- Establish a clear, structured, publically accessible online presence for information covering money, academic, social and healthcare issues.
- 2. Outreach work should paint a realistic picture of higher education, delivered by current students.
- Previous course timetables should be made available pre-application—this will assist students to build up a picture of what is expected of them.
- 4. Higher education providers should create an online chat on their websites to provide anonymised support.
- 5. Mature students and students with dependants are inspiring! Celebrate them!

- 6. Work more closely with housing services to support students in private renting.
- Improve and expand mental health support. Work with specialist third parties to embed support into the institution itself.
