



Student Advisory Group 'Helping Students to Succeed' Manifesto

1. Establish a clear, structured, publically accessible online presence for information covering money, academic, social and healthcare issues.
2. Outreach work should paint a realistic picture of higher education, delivered by current students.
3. Previous course timetables should be made available pre-application—this will assist students to build up a picture of what is expected of them.
4. Higher education providers should create an online chat on their websites to provide anonymised support.
5. Mature students and students with dependants are inspiring! Celebrate them!
6. Work more closely with housing services to support students in private renting.
7. Improve and expand mental health support. Work with specialist third parties to embed support into the institution itself.
8. Students are overwhelmed by careers resources. Signpost approved, high quality IAG around careers, skills training and post-HE progression.
9. Educate and upskill students around the attributes needed to pursue a career.
